HISTORY OF THE BUILDING PROJECT

In 1997, Prof Ken Nakazawa (immediate past chairman of Asia Community Service) secured a RM 30,000 grant from Mitsubishi Foundation towards the building project. This was followed by a RM 418,000 pledge by Nippon Foundation in 1998. In the same year, a charity dinner under the patronage of the then Penang Governor and His Consort which was held at Hotel Equatorial raised RM 93,000.

Despite financial backing, we did not seem to be making headway. We faced difficulties in obtaining approval for the conversion of land and the building plans. Throughout this period of negotiation, we exercised much patience.

Nevertheless, we were determined to fulfill our pledges to potential user members whom we had identified in the community. In 2000, we started the Stepping Stone Centre in a rented premise in Taman Sri Indah with financial support from the Postal Savings International Voluntary Aid (POSIVA).

Newly appointed architect firm, BYG came into the picture in 2000 and re-submitted fresh applications to the local authorities. In 2001, we managed to convert the land usage and in mid-2002, we obtained the planning permission and the approval to build.

After successful tendering, the main contractor was appointed in August 2002. Five months later, the building was fully constructed. The Occupational Certificate was issued in June 2003. Lions' Club International Foundation contributed RM 79,000 towards the purchase of equipment and furniture. Finally in August 2003, after intense preparation and excitement, 13 members, supported by four full-time staff proudly started work in the new building in August 2003.

This building project would not have taken off the ground without the support from many, many people – both local and overseas. There is still a shortfall of RM 25,000 for the building. An estimated expenditure of RM 8,000 per month is required to sustain this project.

We are grateful for the contributions and grants that we have received from overseas. However, the future of this project must depend on the local community not just to sustain the work begun but moreover to continue enhancing the lives of people with disabilities towards independent living.
